Summary

The present report contains information received from Member States on their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data are available. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports from 30 Governments.

I. Introduction

1. The General Assembly, in paragraph 1 of its resolution 66/20, endorsed the report of the Group of Governmental Experts on the Operation and Further Development of the United Nations Standardized Instrument for Reporting Military Expenditures (see A/66/89 and Corr.1-3), the recommendations contained therein and the new title of the instrument, namely, the United Nations Report on Military Expenditures.

2. In paragraph 2, the General Assembly called upon Member States to report annually to the Secretary-General their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data were available, using preferably and to the extent possible, one of the reporting forms, including a “nil” report if appropriate.¹

II. Action taken

3. On 12 March 2012, the United Nations Office for Disarmament Affairs sent a note verbale to Member States requesting them to submit their reports no later than 30 April 2012 and annexed thereto new reporting forms, including a nil return form, that were adopted by the Group of Governmental Experts and endorsed by the General Assembly. The replies received are reproduced in section III below. Any further reports received from Member States will be issued as addenda to the present report.

4. In the margins of the 2012 session of the United Nations Disarmament Commission, the Office for Disarmament Affairs held a briefing on the United Nations Report on Military Expenditures, particularly the changes introduced pursuant to the recommendations made by the Group of Governmental Experts.

5. Furthermore, the Secretary-General made a reference to the United Nations Standardized Instrument for Reporting Military Expenditures (now the United Nations Report on Military Expenditures), in relation to confidence-building measures in the field of conventional arms (see A/66/176). That report provides an overview of such measures, as received by the United Nations through national submissions. It indicated that some confidence-building measures focus on information exchange, seeking to enhance the mutual understanding of national military capabilities and activities and to facilitate regular communication to avoid surprise or unsought military confrontations, with the exchange of military information on national forces and armaments as a key example.

6. The report also indicated that regions and subregions wishing to develop regional confidence-building measures in the field of conventional arms might build upon existing measures with a global reach, such as the United Nations Report on Military Expenditures. They could, for instance, conduct regular bilateral or regional discussions on information provided by Member States from their region to this global instrument and on the strategic considerations underpinning the policy

decisions reported therein. The Office for Disarmament Affairs stands ready to assist States if they so wish in such endeavours.

III. Replies received from Governments

Explanatory notes

7. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports from 30 Governments. A number of States provided clarifications and additional information on defence planning to explain their military expenditures, as well as military budgets for 2012 and prospects for the following years. This additional information is available from the Office for Disarmament Affairs.

Information on defence spending for 2011

1. Funds amounting to RSD 72,427.1 million were earmarked for the purpose of the 2011 defence budgeting in the Republic of Serbia, including the funds for the supplementary financing of military pensions (RSD 23,620.8 million). These allocations exceed the funds earmarked for 2010 for 6.80 per cent (which equals RSD 67,815.2 million).

2. In 2011, defence spending amounted to RSD 72,377.4 million, which amounts to 99.9 per cent of the entire allocated funds. The structure of the defence spending is as follows:

- military expenditure RSD 48,756.6 million (67.4 per cent)
- military pensions (supplementary funding) RSD 23,620.8 million (32.6 per cent)

3. The funds intended for military expenditure (RSD 48,756.6 million) were spent per cost categories as follows:

(a) Operational costs in the amount of RSD 44,314.1 million (90.9 per cent), including RSD 28,315.1 million for salaries and extra payments of the personnel in the Armed Forces and the Ministry of Defence and RSD 15,999.0 million for regular maintenance related to logistic support, training and other tasks within the scope of routine activities;

(b) Procurement and construction costs in the amount of RSD 4,398.8 million (9.0 per cent), including RSD 3,005.4 million for armament and military equipment acquisitions and RSD 1,393.4 million for the construction and maintenance of military facilities;

(c) Research and development costs in the amount of RSD 43.7 million (0.1 per cent).

4. The military spending structure indicates that the largest portion of resources is allocated for the tasks within the scope of regular duties and income payments (90.9 per cent), thus considerably limiting the funds for armament and military equipment acquisitions and for the construction of military facilities and residential units, and for scientific research and development work. Under such circumstances, the procurement of modern and more complex technical systems is rendered impossible so that it all amounts to general overhaul and minor technical upgrades, and the acquisition of ammunition and general-purpose movables. There is a similar situation in the military construction domain where the funds were spent on the construction and purchase of buildings and facilities and on capital maintenance. The spent funds primarily provided better work conditions for the personnel, while the facilities for housing material resources were neglected owing to the insufficient amount of allocated funds. The inability to resolve the housing issue for the members of the Serbian Armed Forces and the Ministry of Defence with the funds

that have been allocated from the budget for that purpose for years poses a separate problem. Those needs and further defence reform have initiated the enactment of a master plan by the Government of the Republic of Serbia with a view to providing funds through selling the surplus real estate and movables that would be used for financing the reform of the Armed Forces and purchase of residential units for members of the Serbian Armed Forces and the Ministry of Defence.

5. In 2011, compared to 2010, the expenditures of equipment acquisitions and general overhaul and modernization of armament and military equipment items amounted to RSD 3,005.3 million, and they were reduced by RSD 83.9 million.

6. A modest sum that equals 0.1 per cent of the total resources spent on military expenditure was apportioned to research and development, which is at the same level as the previous expenditure but far below the real needs.
