#### *Summary*

The present report contains information received from Member States on their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data are available. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports from 38 Governments.

## **I. Introduction**

1. The General Assembly, in paragraph 2 of its resolution 66/20, called upon Member States to report annually to the Secretary-General on their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data were available, using preferably and to the extent possible one of the standardized reporting forms, including a “nil” report if appropriate.<sup>1</sup>

## **II. Actions taken by the Secretariat**

2. On 18 March 2013, the Office for Disarmament Affairs sent a note verbale to Member States requesting them to submit their reports no later than 30 April 2013. The replies received are reproduced in section III below. Any additional reports received from Member States will be issued as addenda to the present report.

3. Over the past year, the Office for Disarmament Affairs has developed an online reporting tool that enables Member States to report on military expenditures in an efficient and secure manner. A briefing on the use of this online tool was provided on the margins of the 2013 session of the United Nations Disarmament Commission. Information sessions were also held on the margins of the meetings of the First Committee of the General Assembly and in the context of the United Nations Disarmament Fellowship Programme.

4. Moreover, pursuant to a recommendation by the Group of Governmental Experts on the Operation and Further Development of the United Nations Standardized Instrument for Reporting Military Expenditures (see A/66/89, para. 72 (i), and Corrs.1-3), the Office for Disarmament Affairs is in the process of overhauling the existing database on military expenditures with a view to making it more user-friendly and up-to-date technologically and to increase its functionality. The new online database is expected to be launched by the end of 2013 ([www.un.org/disarmament/convarms/milex](http://www.un.org/disarmament/convarms/milex)).

## **III. Replies received from Governments**

### **Explanatory notes**

5. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports from 38 Governments. A number of States provided clarifications and additional information on defence planning to explain their military expenditures, as well as military budgets for 2013 and prospects for the following years. This additional information is available to Governments upon request (please write to [conventionalarms-unoda@un.org](mailto:conventionalarms-unoda@un.org)).

6. The originals of the replies from States are available at the Office for Disarmament Affairs.
