Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 19th plenary meeting, on 23 October 2019, the General Assembly, at the request of the Secretary-General ([A/74/294](#)), decided to include in the agenda of its seventy-fourth session, under the agenda item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments”, a sub-item entitled “Appointment of members and alternate members of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
2. At its 9th meeting, on 11 November 2019, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General ([A/C.5/74/9](#)) concerning a vacancy in the membership of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee as a result of the resignation of Hitoshi Kozaki (Japan). By that note, the Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of Japan and the endorsement by the Group of Asia-Pacific States of Tomoya Yamaguchi (Japan) to fill that vacancy.
3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Yamaguchi as a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for a term of office beginning on _____ 2019¹ and ending on 31 December 2020 (see para. 4).

Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint Tomoya Yamaguchi (Japan) as a member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for a term of office beginning on _____ 2019¹ and ending on 31 December 2020.
