Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Luis Mariano Hermosillo Sosa (Mexico) from the International Civil Service Commission, effective 22 February 2021. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Hermosillo Sosa, which expires on 31 December 2021.
2. The Government of Mexico has nominated Claudia Angélica Bueno Reynaga to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Mr. Hermosillo Sosa.
3. The appointment of the members of the Commission is governed by the provisions of articles 3 to 5 of its statute. Pursuant to those provisions, and in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 of section II of General Assembly resolution [43/226](#), the Secretary-General has undertaken consultations with Member States, through the chairs of the various regional groups, with the executive heads of the other organizations, with staff representatives through the Federation of International Civil Servants' Associations and the Coordinating Committee for International Staff Unions and Associations of the United Nations System and with the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions.
4. The Secretary-General thus submits to the General Assembly for its consideration the candidate nominated for membership in the International Civil Service Commission to fill the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Hermosillo Sosa.
