## Social development challenges faced by persons with albinism

### Note by the Secretariat

1. In paragraph 11 of its resolution [74/123](#), the General Assembly requested the Secretary-General to present a report to the Assembly at the main part of its seventy-sixth session, under the item entitled “Social development”, on the various social development challenges faced by persons with albinism, taking into consideration the specific needs of women and children, including those related to social inclusion, health, education and employment, and measures taken, with recommendations for further action to be taken by Member States and other relevant stakeholders to address identified challenges, and encouraged the Secretary-General to collect information from Member States and all relevant organizations and bodies of the United Nations system in the preparation of the report.

2. In the light of the financial constraints faced by the Organization, the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights was unable to support the preparation of the report in time for the main part of the seventy-sixth session and aims to submit the report later during the session.
