DRAFT INTERNATIONAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

Draft Resolution suggested by the Chairman

THE THIRD COMMITTEE

DECIDES to set up a sub-committee composed of the following eleven members: Australia, Belgium, China, Cuba, Ecuador, France, Lebanon, Poland, Union of the Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom and United States to examine the totality of the Declaration of Human Rights, i.e. the 29 articles and the Preamble, adopted by the Third Committee, solely from the standpoint of arrangement, consistency and uniformity and to submit proposals thereon to the Third Committee.

This Sub-Committee in turn will set up a language group of five members, one for each of the official languages, to check and secure the exact correspondence of the text in the five official languages.
