### RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

[*on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/52/744/Add.1)*]

**52/225. Salary and retirement allowance of the Secretary-General and salary and pensionable remuneration of the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme**

*The General Assembly,*

*Having considered* the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>1</sup>

1. *Concurs* with the recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions concerning the salary and retirement allowance of the Secretary-General contained in paragraph 8 of its report;<sup>1</sup>

2. *Also concurs* with the recommendation of the Advisory Committee concerning the salary and pensionable remuneration of the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme contained in paragraph 8 of its report;

3. *Approves* the amendment to annex I to the Staff Regulations of the United Nations with effect from 1 January 1998, as set forth in the annex to the present resolution.

**ANNEX**

**Amendment to annex I to the Staff Regulations of  
the United Nations**

At the end of paragraph 1 of annex I to the Staff Regulations of the United Nations, add the following sentence: "With effect from 1 January 1998, the Administrator of the United Nations Development Programme shall receive a gross salary of 175,344 United States dollars per annum".
