Report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of resolution 2420 (2018) ([S/2019/380](#))

The agenda was adopted without objection.

The President drew attention to the text of a draft resolution contained in document [S/2019/470](#), submitted by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The Council proceeded to vote on the draft resolution ([S/2019/470](#)) before it.

Decision: The draft resolution ([S/2019/470](#)) received 15 votes in favour, none against and no abstentions, and was adopted unanimously as resolution 2473 (2019).

Statements were made by the representatives of the United Kingdom, Belgium, France, South Africa, Côte d'Ivoire, Germany and Indonesia.

Report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo ([S/2019/461](#))

The agenda was adopted without objection.

The President invited the representative of Serbia to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

The President invited the following briefers to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure: Mr. Zahir Tanin, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo; and Mr. João Miguel Ferreira de Serpa Soares, Under-Secretary-General for Legal Affairs and United Nations Legal Counsel.

The President invited Ms. Vlora Çitaku to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

The Council began its consideration of the item and heard briefings by Mr. Tanin (via video-teleconference from Priština) and by Mr. Ferreira de Serpa Soares.

The Council heard a statement by His Excellency Ivica Dačić, First Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Serbia.

The Council heard a statement by Ms. Çitaku.

Statements were made by the representatives of China, South Africa, the United States, the United Kingdom, Germany, France, Indonesia, Equatorial Guinea, Côte d'Ivoire, the Dominican Republic, Belgium, Poland, Peru, the Russian Federation and by the President, speaking in his capacity as the representative of Kuwait.

Mr. Tanin responded to comments and questions raised.

The representative of Germany made a further statement.
