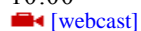

Round table 1: technology, digitalization and ICTs for the empowerment and inclusion of persons with disabilities - Item 5 (b) (i)

Chaired by His Excellency Pekka Puustinen, Under-Secretary of State in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Finland, Vice-President of the bureau, the meeting began its continued consideration of agenda item 5 (a) general debate, and heard statements by the representatives of: San Marino, Senegal, Zambia, Algeria, Qatar, El Salvador, Morocco, Viet Nam, Belgium, Sri Lanka, Senegal; and also from representatives from civil society organizations from Dementia Alliance International and Disability Federation of Ireland.

Under the agenda item 5 (b) (i), the Roundtable one on technology, digitalization and ICTs for the empowerment and inclusion of persons with disabilities was co-chaired by His Excellency Pekka Puustinen, Under-Secretary of State in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Finland, Vice-President of the bureau of the meeting and Mr. Mosharraf Hossain, Director of Global Policy, Influencing and Research, at the Action on Disability and Development, ADD International.

Presentations were made by five panellists: Ms. Tytti Matsinen, a Disability Inclusion Adviser of Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Finland who participated via video-connection; Ms. Inmaculada Placencia, Senior Expert in the Unit Disability & Inclusion at the European Commission; Ms. Nirmita Narasimhan, a Policy Fellow of LIRNE Asia and Senior Fellow and Programme Director at the Global Initiative for Inclusive ICTs (G3ICT) in Bengaluru, India and Mr. James Thurston, Vice-President for Global Strategy and Development, of the Global Initiative for Inclusive ICTs (G3ict).
