Review of Sustainable Development Goals 4, 8, 10, 13, 16 and 17 - Item 2 (a)

Discussion on SDG 10: "Reduce inequality within and among countries"

The Vice-President of the Council (Belarus) opened the meeting and made a statement.

The representative of the Statistics Division of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs presented a statistical snapshot on SDG 10.

The discussion was moderated by the Director of the Center on International Cooperation at New York University, Ms. Sarah Cliffe, who made a statement and conducted a live polling in preparation for the interactive discussion.

Statements were made by the following resource persons: Justice Edwin Cameron of the Constitutional Court of South Africa; Lecturer in Public Policy at the Harvard Kennedy School, Affiliated Professor at the Harvard Graduate School of Design, and Senior Advisor for Women in Informal Employment: Globalizing and Organizing Network, Ms. Martha Chen; the Assistant Director-General of the Economic and Social Development Department of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United



Nations, Mr. Máximo Torero Cullen; and the Dean of the Graduate School of Ewha Womans University of Korea, Ms. Eun Mee Kim.

Statements were also made by the lead discussants: the Secretary General of the International Federation on Ageing, Ms. Jane Barratt; the Executive Director of the Fiji Women's Rights Movement, Ms. Nalini Singh; and the Director of Development Finance International, Mr. Matthew Martin.

An interactive discussion ensued, during which the resource persons responded to comments made and questions posed by the representatives of the Republic of Korea (on behalf of the member countries of the Group of Friends of SDG 10: Argentina, Bangladesh, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Chile, the Czech Republic, El Salvador, France, Guatemala, Iraq, Israel, Italy, Jamaica, Liechtenstein, the Netherlands, Peru, the Philippines, the Republic of Korea, Romania, Switzerland, Tunisia and Viet Nam), Israel, Finland, Zambia, France, Norway, El Salvador, Poland, Thailand, the Netherlands, Indonesia, Sweden, Bangladesh, Nepal, the Czech Republic, Zimbabwe, South Africa, Azerbaijan, Mexico, Switzerland, the European Union, Niger, Guatemala, Spain, Morocco, Viet Nam; the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, China, Germany and the Philippines.

The Vice-President of the Council (Morocco) opened the meeting and made a statement.

Keynote statement

The forum heard a keynote statement by the United Nation Secretary-General's Special Envoy for the 2019 Climate Action Summit, Mr. Luis Alfonso de Alba.

The discussion was moderated by the Deputy Executive Secretary of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, Mr. Ovais Sarmad, who made a statement.

The forum heard presentations by the following speakers: the Minister of Environment of Chile, and President of COP-25 of UNFCCC, Her Excellency Carolina Schmidt; the Co-Chair of the Secretary-General's Climate Science Advisory Group, Ms. Leena Srivastava; the Deputy Executive Director of the Green Climate Fund, Mr. Javier Manzanares; the Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Disaster Risk Reduction, Ms. Mami Mizutori; the Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia, Ms. Rola Dashti; the

Commissioner of New York City Mayor's Office for International Affairs, Ms. Penny Abeywardena; Chairman of Xiamen Airlines of China, Mr. Zhao Dong; and a young farmer, WFO, of the Farmers' Major Group, Ms. Dimakatso (Nono) Sekhoto.
