
DRAFT RESOLUTION SUBMITTED BY THE REPRESENTATIVE
OF ARGENTINA AT THE 427TH MEETING, 16 JUNE 1949,
CONCERNING THE ADMISSION OF PORTUGAL TO MEMBERSHIP
IN THE UNITED NATIONS

The Security Council,

Noting General Assembly resolution 197 (III), C, of
8 December 1948, regarding the application of PORTUGAL for membership
in the United Nations,

Decides that in its judgment PORTUGAL is a peace-loving State and
is able and willing to carry out the obligations contained in the Charter;
and accordingly,

Recommends to the General Assembly that it admit PORTUGAL to
membership in the United Nations.
