Letter dated 28 September 2018 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2432 \(2018\)](#), by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Mali until 30 September 2019 and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

I have designated Mr. de Koning to serve as the Coordinator of the Panel.
