The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported five incidents of gunfire: four in Ladhqiyah Governorate and one in Aleppo Governorate.

The Turkish representative office has reported 18 incidents of gunfire in the following Governorates: 12 in Hama, 5 in Aleppo and 1 in Idlib.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

The Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides and Refugee Migration Monitoring has not carried out any humanitarian operations over the past 24 hours.

In total, 2,115 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 3,370.855 tons.
