### Letter dated 6 April 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2564 \(2021\)](#), adopted on 25 February 2021, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Yemen until 28 March 2022.

I have designated Ms. Gunaratne to serve as Coordinator of the Panel. One additional expert will be appointed shortly.
