DRAFT RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF JAPAN
FOR ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP IN THE UNITED NATIONS

Submitted by the representative of the United States of America

The Security Council

Having received and considered the application of Japan for membership
in the United Nations (S/2673 of 23 June 1952),

Decides that, in its judgment, Japan is a peace-loving State and is able
and willing to carry out the obligations contained in the Charter, and
accordingly

Recommends to the General Assembly that it admit Japan to membership in
the United Nations.
