### Meeting venue

The Forty-second Meeting of Heads of National Drug Law Enforcement Agencies (HONLEA), Asia and the Pacific, will be held from 2 to 5 October 2018 at the headquarters of the Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP), United Nations Building, Rajadamnern Nok Avenue, Bangkok, Thailand.

The meeting will take place in Conference Room 2, 2nd Floor of the United Nations Building.
