The following is the text of a message to the Secretary-General received on 20 May 1967 from Mr. Mahmoud Riad, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the United Arab Republic:

"On the occasion of the withdrawal of the United Nations forces from the United Arab Republic and Gaza Strip, I wish to express to you, on behalf of my Government, our thanks and appreciation of the efforts and sincere co-operation the United Nations and its forces have shown in the United Arab Republic. I hope that you would convey to the officers and soldiers of UNEF our appreciation of the discharge of their duties during their stay. This expression of appreciation is also addressed to the Governments to which these forces belong. In conclusion, may I express to you my appreciation of your personal efforts and understanding of our clear position and your belief in the United Nations and its mission. With my personal regards."
