Генеральная Ассамблея Семьдесят третья сессия Пункт 45 повестки дня Кипрский вопрос Совет Безопасности Семьдесят четвертый год

### Письмо Временного поверенного в делах Постоянного представительства Кипра при Организации Объединенных Наций от 17 апреля 2019 года на имя Генерального секретаря

По поручению правительства моей страны настоящим препровождаю четыре документа, содержащих сведения о совершенных Турцией вторжениях в национальное воздушное пространство Кипра, нарушениях международных правил воздушного движения в районе полетной информации Кипра, а также незаконном использовании ею закрытых портов и аэропортов на Кипре в январе и феврале 2019 года (см. приложения I–IV)\*.

Эта продолжающаяся политика, проводимая в нарушение норм международного права и международных правил и положений, создает постоянную угрозу для международного мира и безопасности, негативно влияет на региональную стабильность, ставит под угрозу безопасность международной гражданской авиации, создает трудности для воздушного движения над Кипром и препятствует созданию благоприятных условий для осуществления кипрского мирного процесса.

Турция посредством радиообмена продолжает систематически создавать помехи для гражданской и военной авиации в районе полетной информации Никосии, и в этот же период режим, установленный оккупирующей державой в оккупируемом ею районе Кипра, незаконно направил четыре извещения для авиационного персонала в связи с учениями, проводившимися турецкими военновоздушными силами. Кроме того, самолеты турецких коммерческих авиакомпаний систематически используют аэропорт Тимбу, который продолжает незаконно эксплуатироваться с момента закрытия правительством Кипра всех пунктов въезда в районах, в которых оно не осуществляет действенного контроля.

Вышеупомянутые действия Турции, которая с 1974 года незаконно оккупирует северную часть Республики Кипр, явно рассчитаны на подрыв суверенитета Кипра, закрепление сохраняющегося фактического раздела и повышение статуса сепаратистского образования путем предъявления претензий на

воздушное пространство над оккупированной территорией Республики. В этой связи я хотела бы подчеркнуть, что существует только одно кипрское государство — Республика Кипр, как это предусмотрено в различных резолюциях Совета Безопасности (в частности, в резолюциях 541 (1983) и 550 (1984)), в которых Совет объявил так называемое отделение части Кипра не имеющим законной силы.

От имени правительства моей страны я заявляю решительный протест в связи с продолжающимися вторжениями Турции в национальное воздушное пространство и территориальные воды Кипра, а также нарушениями ею международных правил воздушного движения и призываю к их немедленному прекращению.

В этой связи Республика Кипр вновь обращается с призывом ко всем государствам соблюдать резолюции Совета Безопасности и закрепленные в Уставе Организации Объединенных Наций принципы суверенитета и невмешательства.

И наконец, я хотела бы настоятельно призвать Турцию и киприотов-турок содействовать конструктивному возобновлению мирного процесса, вместо того чтобы направлять все усилия на подрыв суверенитета Республики Кипр и закрепление раздела Кипра посредством изменения положения дел на местах и закрепления статуса-кво, включая повышение политического статуса этого сепаратистского образования.

Буду признательна Вам за распространение настоящего письма и приложений к нему в качестве документа Генеральной Ассамблеи по пункту 45 повестки дня и документа Совета Безопасности.
