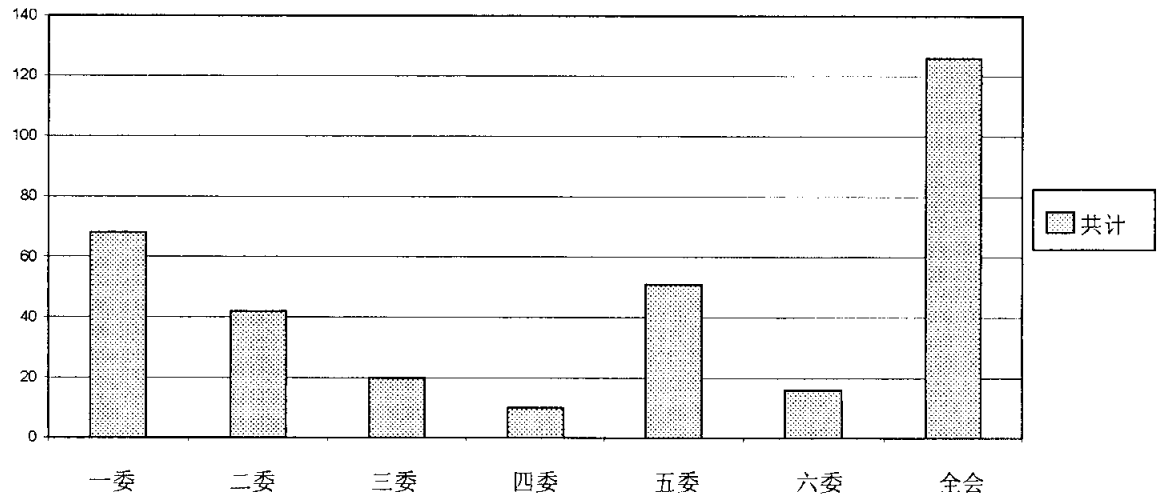
2. 应大会主席的要求，秘书处特此编写本说明，以方便审议此事。
3. 大会议程是一份不断变化的文件，每届会议都增加新的项目和分项目；有些项目的标题，不同的届会有所变动。有些项目如已失去现实意义，便予以删除。

8. 在附件中，“届会”和“年份”两栏（见 H 项）表示某个项目何时列入议程，应何方请求列入议程。

9. “行动历史”栏（见 I 项）载有上届会议审议该项目的情况。

10. “会议次数”一栏（见 I 项）说明分配多少次会议审议该议程。

11. 发言人数（见 I 项）系指上届会议审议该项目时的发言人数。

12. 在“报告数目”栏（见 I 项）中，方括号内的数目系指增编文件数，“*”号表示该文件在几个项目下印发。

13. 下列项目或分项目是新的，其审议频率不得而知，因此列为每年审议的项目。

- 预防武装冲突（全会项目）
- 遵守各项军备限制和裁军及不扩散协定（第一委员会项目）
- 增进第一委员会工作方法的效力（第一委员会项目）
- 区域和分区域建立信任措施（第一委员会项目）

二. 结论意见

14. 希望本说明所提供的事实材料有助于各代表团找到精简大会议程的方法。譬如，只要浏览一下全会项目，就可以看出 10 个项目是“休眠”项目，亦即过去十年没有采取任何实质性行动的项目（见附件七）。如果此种项目应保留在议程上，大会不妨考虑将其列入“非活跃项目表”，必要时重新列入“活跃议程”。对于分配给各主要委员会的议程项目来说，“休眠”项目并非那么显而易见。

15. 还可以考虑再进一步。如 A/58/CRP.4 所示，联合国的议程与优先目标看来存在错位现象。我们为何要找到一个将所有项目装进去的框架？难道不该考虑拟定一个符合《中期计划》或《千年宣言》所反映的联合国优先目标的议程项目单？可以采取的一个做法是，将长期议程与某届会议的实际议程区分开来。这样做有个好处，那就是每届会议的实际议程可以反映联合国当时的优先目标。

16. 附件二载列了大会议程上每年审议的所有项目。可对这个一览表进行检视，以便将更多的项目定为两年或三年审议一次的项目。这样做还有利分门别类，将

类似的项目合并，以利于讨论。这一点同等重要。应当指出，并非所有主要委员会都采用每两年讨论某些项目的做法。例如，第四和第三委员会议程上只有每年审议的项目。

17. 此外，还可以对载列所有每两年审议的项目的附件三进行审查，看可否将某些项目定为每三年审议的项目。
